First Step for Financial Aid Application

Make sure your [legal name](#) matches your name listed in AERIES to avoid delays with your financial aid.

Applying for financial aid starts October of senior year!

Get a headstart and create an FSA ID during your Junior year.

You and one Parent/Guardian will need one. Be sure to save your username and password!
Step One: get your FSA ID! Don't delay, do this NOW!

The Financial Aid Net Price Calculator provides an estimated Financial Aid Award Offer for prospective students. The estimated values produced by this tool are **not** the actual amounts that will be offered in your final Financial Aid Award Offer. All estimated values are subject to the availability of funding.

CAL GRANT

Cal Grant Awards are FREE money for students pursuing an undergraduate degree or vocational or career training.

It is required that schools submit grade point averages (GPAs) for students to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) for Cal Grant consideration.

You have until January of junior year to [Opt out](#) of GPA Submission

Should I take the PSAT?

Many students take the PSAT, not only as preparation for the SAT taken in senior year but also to qualify for the **National Merit Scholarship Competition** during 11th grade.



- Testing requirements have recently changed for many colleges and programs. Make sure to check with your specific college if not UC or CSU.

- Try to get you to send money by claiming you're a finalist in a scholarship contest,
- Request your credit card or bank account number to hold a scholarship or grant for you.
- Be wary of free seminars that turn into high-pressure sales pitches for financial aid information that's readily available for free.
- Reputable companies neither guarantee scholarships nor use aggressive tactics.


