Cal Grant Awards are FREE money for students pursuing an undergraduate degree or vocational or career training.

It is required that schools submit grade point averages (GPAs) for students to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) for Cal Grant consideration.

You have until January 31st of JUNIOR year to opt out of GPA Submission.

First Step for Financial Aid Application Make sure yourmatches your name sted in AERIES to avoid delays with your financial aid

- Make sure your <u>legal name</u> on your Social Security card or birth certificate matches your name listed in AERIES to avoid delays with your financial aid
- 2. Get a headstart and create an <u>FSA ID</u> during your Junior year. You and one Parent/Guardian will need one. Be sure to save your username and password! <u>FAFSA</u>* (Free Application for

FederalStudent Aid)<u>Dream Act</u>* Application and info for students who are undocumented. Students without a Social Security Number will wait and fill out the CADAA <u>Dream Act</u> application during their senior year.
